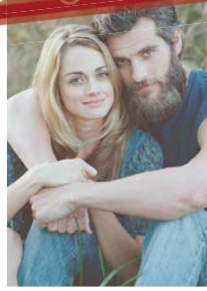


MOVIE DISCUSSION GUIDE:

- ▶ Infidelity is the result of a series of bad decisions that start at the heart level. In order to not fall into temptation it's important to win early. In what ways did Jed lose early on? What should he have done differently?
- ▶ At what point would you call Jed and Shelby's relationship an affair?
- ▶ Looking back, Rose said that she had made mistakes and should have done things differently. What do you think those things were?
